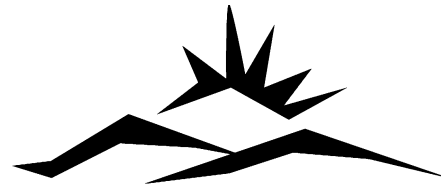

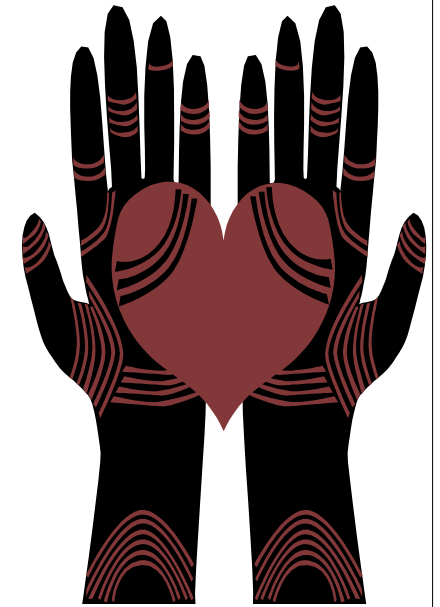

CLIENT SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WITH HIV AT THE CONTRA COSTA HIV/AIDS & STD PROGRAM

The Contra Costa HIV/AIDS & STD Program offers a variety of services to clients with HIV disease. These services are free and confidential.

INTAKE AND REFERRALS FOR CLIENT SERVICES

Our Intake Coordinator serves as a centralized source of information and referral for HIV+ people in Contra Costa County. He refers clients countywide to medical case management services at community based organizations and the County, including referrals to the programs listed below. If you or someone you know is HIV+ and interested in finding out more about services in our county, you can call **925-313-6771**.

MEDICAL CASE MANAGEMENT

Medical Social Workers assist people with HIV by addressing their most immediate needs and connecting them with ongoing medical case management services. Medical Social Workers support people to engage and maintain their health care by assisting to apply for insurance, accessing medications, scheduling appointments, and consulting with your health care provider. **For questions, call 925-313-6771.**

PREVENTION WITH POSITIVES

(PWP) helps people with HIV make a plan to prevent transmission of HIV to others, while maintaining their own health. **925-313-6771**

OUTREACH AND LINKAGE TO CARE

This program offers intensive outreach and support to clients who are out-of-care. Outreach referrals are made for clients who have broken medical appointments, are missing labs, or who need medication adherence support. Outreach is also provided to HIV positive individuals who have never been connected to care. Outreach activities include home visits, phone calls, collateral contacts, case conferencing, etc. to locate clients. **For questions, call 925-313-6771.**

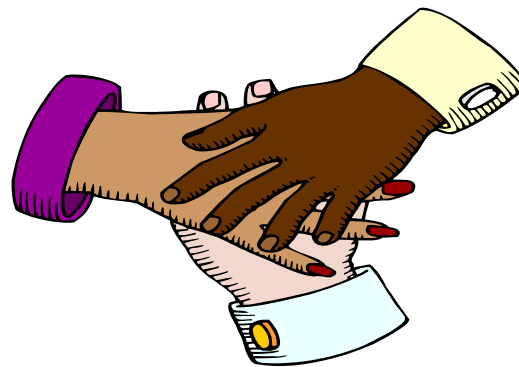
AIDS DRUG ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

(ADAP) This program pays for hundreds of drugs that treat HIV disease. In order to be eligible for ADAP, a person must be HIV positive, a California resident over the age of 18, have limited or no prescription benefits, and meet financial eligibility requirements. 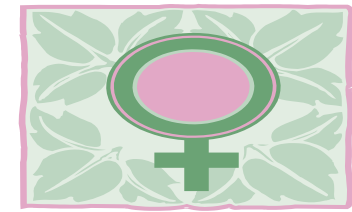


MEDICAL WAIVER NURSE CASE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

A Public Health Nurse and a Medical Social Worker work as a team to provide case management services to people with disabling HIV or AIDS and who have free Medi-Cal. Our goal is to assist clients in remaining independent and at home as long as safely possible. The case managers coordinate services including medical care, attendant care, nutritional counseling, mental health, substance abuse services, and home delivered meals. **For intake or questions, please call 925-313-6771.**



Our team works with people with HIV and other providers to help clients stay healthy. Our Public Health Nurse and Medical Social Workers visit clients at home, helping clients coordinate their services.



MEDICAL SOCIAL WORKER SERVICES AT THE POSITIVE HEALTH CLINICS

HIV/AIDS & STD Program Medical Social Workers are present at each of the Positive Health Clinics to assist HIV+ patients in meeting the goals of their medical treatment plans by providing a variety of services that may include: arranging clinic appointments, providing emotional support, providing HIV health information and risk reduction counseling, coordination with medical care providers, and helping to link clients to the HIV system of care.
